### **WHITE ROCK VINEYARDS ESTATE CHARDONNAY, 2012**

#### **92 POINTS**

White Rock's 2012 Chardonnay is a classy effort displaying good minerality along with hints of poached pears, white peaches, quince and a touch of apple butter. Medium-bodied, fresh, complex and impeccably well-balanced, it displays impressive craftsmanship. Drink it over the next 4-5 years.

### **WHITE ROCK VINEYARDS RESERVE CHARDONNAY, 2012**

#### **93 POINTS**

The 2012 Chardonnay Reserve is made from the estate's oldest vines and is aged 18 months in one-third new French oak. It ratchets up the level of concentration, intensity and richness. The color is a light straw with a green hue. The wine is full-bodied with notes of pears, white peaches, apple skins and quince. Subtle but authoritative with a long finish, it can be enjoyed over the next 5-7 years.

### **WHITE ROCK VINEYARDS CLARET, 2010**

#### **90 POINTS**

The 2010 Claret, a blend of 38% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot, 27% Cabernet Franc and 2% Petit Verdot, reveals a deep ruby/purple color as well as delicious red and black fruit notes intermixed with notions of underbrush and forest. Medium-bodied with abundant fruit as well as a graceful, Bordeaux-like framework and style, this beauty should drink nicely for a decade or more.
