Deep red fruit, white pepper, chalk, blood orange and mint lend notable depth to this powerhouse Cabernet. The tannins are pretty imposing, but there is plenty of fruit to keep things in balance. Our 36-acre family run farm is situated in its own small valley in the southern foothills of the Stag's Leap Range on the historic site of White Rock Vineyards, which dates back to 1870. With a commitment to sustainable natural farming. We have never used herbicides, pesticides, or fumigants in our vineyard. We practice an integrated soil management program designed to ensure the health and fertility of our soils, including native cover crops, hand hoeing and mulching around the vines.
