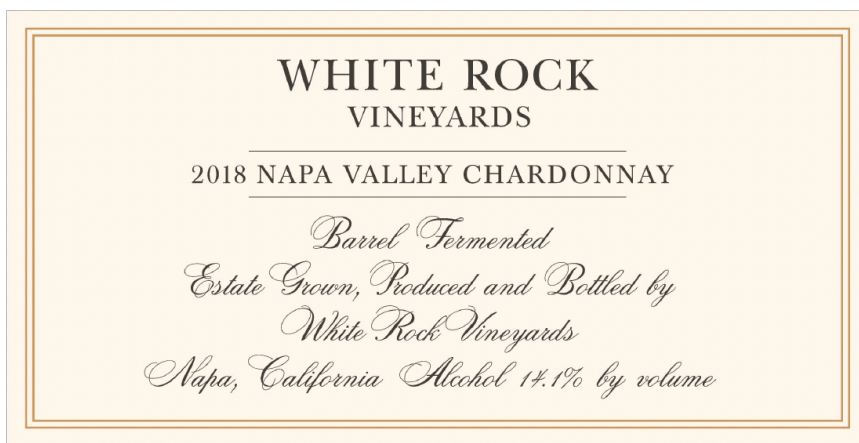
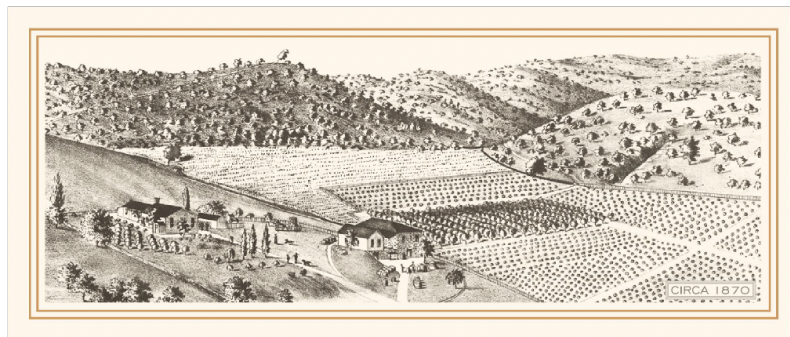

Winemaker Notes: 2018 was a very fruity and floral year with tropical fruit, citrus and melon dominating the palate that yields to a nuanced silky palate of wild honey and white tea, with a crisp mineral finish. The 2018 chardonnay includes 10 percent old vine chardonnay which adds another layer of flavor and silkiness to this wine, while helping balance the bright acidity and floral character. This wine has a nice balance of acidity and soft fruit character.

Our 36-acre family run farm is situated in its own small valley in the southern foothills of the Stag's Leap Range on the historic site of White Rock Vineyards, which dates back to 1870. With a commitment to sustainable natural farming. We have never used herbicides, pesticides, or fumigants in our vineyard. We practice an integrated soil management program designed to ensure the health and fertility of our soils, including native cover crops, hand hoeing and mulching around the vines.
